Dear Mr. Cunningham:

Congratulations! On behalf of the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA), Center for Veterans Enterprise (CVE), upon review of your Request for Reconsideration dated, March 12, 2012, I am writing to inform you that your service-disabled Veteran-owned small business (SDVOSB), Advanced IT Network Solutions, LLC., (the company) has been verified and added to the verified Veteran business database at www.VetBiz.gov. Your business will be eligible to participate in Veterans First Contracting Program opportunities with VA. This verification is valid for up to one year from the date of this letter.

CVE initially denied your business verified status by decision dated June 3, 2011. CVE denied verification for the VetBiz VIP database because we were unable, based on submitted documentation, to conclude that you controlled the company as is required by 38 CFR § 74.4. Specifically, CVE found that your Operating Agreement indicated that your company was managed by Roger Johnson, a non-service-disabled Veteran. With your Request for Reconsideration, you supplied an Operating Agreement indicating in Section 5.1 that management is reserved to the members, and that any reference in the Operating Agreement to managers shall be deemed to refer to members. Since Section 2.4 of the company Operating Agreement states that you are the only member, with 100% membership interest; you have resolved the issue presented in the initial denial letter as to control.

The initial denial letter also stated that VA Form 0877 Verification Application you submitted listed you as a Veteran, and not as a service-disabled Veteran. As such, your business was evaluated as a Veteran-owned small business. However, with your Request for Reconsideration, you delivered to CVE a disability rating letter issued by the Department of Veteran Affairs, establishing a service-connected disability rating of 30%. Based on the foregoing, CVE grants your Request for Reconsideration.

Our goal is to establish a strong Veterans' movement by branding your status as a verified service-disabled Veteran-owned small business. You may use the following
